- Leilani & The Distractions will perform in the EXPANDED EMBERZ BAR!
- Randy Parr will be playing his piano in the window at BeDazzled. You can hear from outside but it is much more fun to go inside and perhaps sing-a-long.
- The group DMV will be performing at Sharon Malone's. Come hear the folksy sound from this trio of musicians. D for Doug, M for Michael and V for Virginia.
- Aloft Art Gallery will have Laurie Lehmann collages & photography, "*Journey Profoundly*" as "Art in the Window," and there will be live music inside to make a lovely browsing experience. "Journey Profoundly" is a combination of collage pieces created during Laurie's battle against cancer. Each piece explored a different emotion as the journey progressed. Laurie has paired these pieces with photographs depicting those emotions.
- Antique Attic presents Rhythm Infuse. The Attic are great hosts. Pull up a chair and listen for a while.

- Legends will feature Neil Fromm and Doug Casner.
- Grover Anderson will be playing at the Sonora Tap Room along with art on the walls from Rachael Brown. Pull up a stool and listen to a set.
- Old Pony and Coyote Steve will be at Funky Junk! Perfect pairing for this great venue.
- Red Pony is back in Sonora at Tradewinds. We love when Red Pony comes to town with their unique sound and fun energy.
- Zac Luchetti is the featured artist at Utilitrn and there will be a musical set by Kylee Luchetti. Zac has been creating art for 25 years. In that time he worked as a high school art. Some high points in his artistic journey include: showing art in the SF MOMA employee's show, the Society of California Pioneers collection, and many other galleries and group shows over northern California. Other experiences include: The Sharpie "write out loud contest",

The New Yorker cover contest and creating illustrations for many people and organizations. His most recent direction is creating comics and painting murals. He contributes, in his way, to the Greater Good.
