Presented in the form of psychedelic collages, a metaphorical casket made of found objects, and a burial gown entitled 'Chrysalis'; this body of work is as playful as it is uncomfortable. Please join us in celebrating the opening of our vintage shop and art gallery while embarking on a visual journey of a young woman's desire to move on from her past.
- Rhythm Infuse, a unique duet featuring Ellie and John Binkley, will be at !New (formerly Funky Junk) performing rock, blues and pop standards from the past to the present.
- Reggie Hein will be the featured Artist in the Window at the Aloft Art Gallery and many of the 39 Aloft Art Gallery artists will be on hand in the gallery to share their works and inspirations.
